Call for Special Issue 2023

The Editorial Board of the *Polish Political Science Yearbook* is inviting proposals for a special issue in 2023

Special issues should be devoted to a theme of general interest to the discipline, relevant across different regions and subfields. The Editorial Board encourages proposals that include contributors working outside Poland. We value gender-balanced proposals.

Special issues should consist of an Editorial Introduction (of c. 6000 words) plus six to eight articles of a maximum of 8000 words apiece that conform to PPSY's submission criteria.

All proposals should include the following:

- Outline of theme. The proposals must explain what is original, new and noteworthy about the proposed collection (1 page).
- Titles and abstracts (250 words) of the proposed articles.
- Name, affiliation and email of contributors.

Prospective guest editors of a special issue should submit proposals in the format of a single PDF document to ppsy.editors@gmail.com by 30 September 2022.

Guest editors will be informed whether their proposal has been accepted by 31 October 2022.

Guest editors will be responsible for ensuring the articles are submitted online by an agreed deadline (most probably 30 June 2023)

The PPSY editors will be responsible for arranging double-blind peer review of the articles. In instances where special issue submissions are not successful in review, then the editors may decide to offer guest editors and authors the option of turning their special issue into a shorter special section in a regular issue, or to publish individual articles as stand-alone papers.
